DESCRIPTION (field, expectations, comments):

Candidates who meet the requirements set out in the Higher Education Act of 20 July, 2018 and in §60 of Statute of Stanisław Moniuszko Academy of Music in Gdańsk may enter the competition.

Qualifications required:

1. possessing at least a M. A. in the field in field of Musical Art, specialty: percussion;
2. teaching experience;
3. documented artistic and organizational achievements;
4. communicative knowledge of the English language;
5. communicative knowledge of the Polish language.

Documents required:

1. Letter of application addressed to the Rector of Stanisław Moniuszko Academy of Music in Gdańsk.
2. A copy of the document confirming the degree, certified either by a notary or in Stanisław Moniuszko Academy of Music in Gdańsk.
3. A personal questionnaire.
4. CV.
5. Documentation confirming the artistic, organizational and teaching achievements.
6. A document confirming the knowledge of the English language (in the absence of such a document, part of the job interview will be held in English).
7. A signed statement that Stanisław Moniuszko Academy of Music in Gdańsk will be the basic place of employment.

Form of competition:

1. performance a 15-20 minute artistic presentation in the form of a recital (free programme), using a variety of instrumentation; list of instruments to be used: marimba – Marimba One, vibraphone – Musser, 5 timpani – ADAMS, snare drums; possible additional instruments on request;
2. presentation of two 15-minute lessons with pupils or students;
3. a presentation of the teaching plan divided into undergraduate and graduate courses (in writing, no more than one A4 page in total – font max. 12 points).
4. job interview in Polish and, in the absence of a document confirming the knowledge of the English language, a part of the job interview – in English;
5. analysis of artistic and organizational achievements.
